Kate Luxford has been Chargé d'Affaires as of July 2023. Before she held the position of Counsellor and Deputy Head of Mission since July 2022.

Prior to Berlin, Kate served as a Director in Middle East Branch of the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade. She has also served in the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet as Senior Adviser, Europe, Middle East and Americas; and in Australia's peak intelligence assessment agency, the Office of National Assessments.

Kate worked as a Middle East analyst and freelance journalist in London and the Middle East before joining the government.

Kate has an MPhil in Modern Middle Eastern Studies from the University of Oxford, where she studied as a Rhodes Scholar. She also holds a Masters of Public Policy from the Australian National University and a Diplôme International d'Administration Publique from France's Ecole Nationale d'Administration. She speaks French, German and Arabic.
